

Agenda 47 | Ending the Scourge of Drug Addiction in America

"We will not rest until we have ended the drug addiction crisis. For three decades before my election, drug overdose deaths increased every single year. Under my leadership, we took the drug and fentanyl crisis head on, and we achieved the first reduction in overdose deaths in more than thirty years."

- 1. Impose a full naval embargo on drug cartels and deploy military assets to inflict maximum damage on cartel operations.
- 2. Insist on the full cooperation of neighboring governments to dismantle the trafficking and smuggling networks in our region.
- 3. Ask Congress to ensure drug dealers and human traffickers receive the death penalty.
- 4. Direct U.S. federal law enforcement to take down the gangs and organized street crime that distribute these deadly narcotics on a local level.
- 5. Permanently designate fentanyl as a federally controlled substance.
- 6. Tell China that if they do not clamp down on the export of fentanyl's chemical precursors, they will pay a steep price.
- 7. Strengthen the pillars of work, faith, and family which give life meaning and hope to those struggling with addiction.
- 8. Make it easier for those suffering from addiction to seek treatment without losing their jobs.
- 9. Forge new public-private partnerships for companies willing to provide job opportunities and skills training to former addicts.
- 10. Expand federal support for faith-based counseling, treatment, and recovery programs.

President Trump will ensure that parents, children, spouses, or other relatives who need to care for family members fighting to overcome addiction, can take advantage of a family leave program.
